Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 100%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.
- 2. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

1. Scope of Supply

Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components): Only supply of Goods

2. Inspection

THIRD PARTY INSPECTION for IOCL:

Goods and Services shall be subjected to stage wise and final inspection by any of the IOCL approved Third Party Inspection (TPI) agency (list attached), and TPI charges are included in quoted prices, and no additional charges shall be paid by Owner.

It will be bidder's responsibility to arrange for third party inspection and submit the third party inspection release note on time. No time extension shall be allowed by IOCL for any delay/lapse in this regard.

Quoted prices are:

- i. i) Inclusive of charges for all facilities required for testing and all inspection requirements specified in the technical specifications and documents enclosed with the TENDER inclusive of destructive testing charges (if any), all expenses like travel, incidental and fees payable to third party inspectors.
- ii. ii) Inclusive of all IBR/IGC/NACE/Radiography charges as per IOCL's technical specifications and the documents enclosed with the TENDER.
- iii. iii) All built in import content (if applicable) shall also be subjected to inspection by any of IOCL approved TPI agency, in the country of origin of the import content, and charges for the same are included in quoted prices, and no additional charges shall be paid by Owner.

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3. Past Project Experience

Commercial Experience Criteria for Goods:

For experience, the order(s) executed by the bidder, during the last five years ending on the last day of the month immediately preceding the month in which the last date of bid submission falls, should be considered as under:

Three orders each executed for "similar item" Supply of "Heat exchangers/coolers/Tube bundles of exchangers" where executed value is not less than the amount equal to Rs. 446931.

OR

Two orders each executed for "similar item" Supply of "Heat exchangers/coolers/Tube bundles of exchangers" where executed value is not less than the amount equal to Rs. 595908.

OR

One order executed for "similar item" Supply of "Heat exchangers/coolers/Tube bundles of exchangers" where executed value is not less than the amount equal to Rs. 744885.

FOB/FCA/FOR Dispatch point price (inclusive of P&F, if any) shall be considered for arriving at the executed order value. However, in case any other cost component like TPI charges, Freight charges, Taxes & Duties etc. are not indicated separately and are already included in the Purchase Order Value, as evident from the submitted Purchase order copies, then executed order value shall include such inclusive cost components also for the purpose of PQC evaluation.

Last date of order execution may fall in the above mentioned period i.e. within last five years ending on the last day of the month immediately preceding the month in which the last date of bid submission falls without considering any extensions.

Foreign Orders in currency other than USD shall be converted to USD on the date of the said Purchase Order.

4. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

For fulfilling the commercial experience criteria any one of the following documents may be considered as valid proof for meeting the criteria:

- i) Copies of relevant PO (Purchase Orders) along with Invoice(s) with self certification by bidder that supplies against the invoices covering the "similar order" have been executed to the required value.
- ii) Purchase Order copy along with Bank Certificate indicating payment against the PO
- iii) Purchase Order copy along with Execution certificate by client with order value
- iv) Purchase Order copy along with Goods Receipt Note (GRNs) in case where IOCL is a client
- v) Purchase Order copy along with Invoice(s) and Third Party Inspection Release Note or LR/RR/AWB/Bill of Lading or any other document with reference of PO / Invoice in support of execution of PO
- vi) In case any other document is submitted by bidder in support of execution, the same shall be properly checked by the concerned officers before acceptance.

Notwithstanding any other condition / provision in the tender documents, bidders are required to submit complete documents pertaining to PQC alongwith their offer. Failure to meet the PQC will render the bid to be summarily rejected.

IOC reserves the right to complete the evaluation based on the details furnished by the bidder, with or without seeking any additional supporting documents / clarifications.

Payment Term:

Payment for all the goods and services shall be made within 45 days from the day of acceptance / deemed acceptance.

The day of acceptance shall be the day of actual delivery of goods or rendering of services. However, if any objection is made in writing by the buyer within 15 days from the day of

the delivery of goods or rendering of services, the day of acceptance shall be the day on which such objection is removed by the vendor. If no objection is made in writing by the buyer within 15 days, day of actual delivery of goods or rendering of services shall be the day of deemed acceptance.
